


Game 1: Badge of Knowledge

The Good Samaritan Drug Overdose Act is a law that protects people who seek help during an overdose. The Act aims to reduce the fear of getting in trouble if police respond to an overdose (even if you have taken a drug or have some on you) and encourages people to help save a life.



Task: Find your way to the one place you can get a naloxone kit.




Game 4: Badge of Distinction

Know the importance of giving naloxone and seeking further medical attention.




